Grades 4-6

Lesson 22.1-22.3: We learned about the division of the united kingdom of Israel and the prophets Amos, Hosea and Isaiah.

Objectives: Students are able to

- 1) recall the division of Solomon's kingdom into the northern kingdom of Israel and the southern kingdom of Judah;
- 2) describe the apostasy of Israel, the prophetic warning of Amos, Hosea and Isaiah, as well as Israel's fall at the hands of the Assyrians and Judah's fall at the hands of the Babylonians.

Class Activities:

- 1) Studied the chronological order of the prophets and corresponding kings of both Israel and Judah, and the prophets' books in the Bible;
- 2) Discussed Amos 3:1-2, 11; 5:10-12, 26-27; Hosea 1:1; 4:1-2; 8:2-7; 11:1-5; Isaiah 1:1-4, 15-20; 2 Kings 20:16-17; Isaiah 9:1-21; Luke 1:30-33.
- 3) Discussed that Isaiah was given a prophecy revealing God's plan for redemption in Christ at about 750 years before Jesus was born.
