Lesson 24.3-24.4: Jesus' Early Years: Escape to Egypt and Jesus at the Temple

Objectives:

1. Explain why Joseph and his family had to escape to Egypt;
2. Learn about the story of Jesus' parents finding him at the temple when they discovered he was not with them.

Class Activities:

1. We discussed why Joseph's family had to escape to Egypt. Students read Matthew 2:1-23 and interpreted each verse. We also discussed the Bible verses that prophesied that boy babies in Israel would be killed and that Jesus would one day be called out of Egypt (Hosea, Jeremiah, Micah);
2. We studied Luke 2:41-52 and discussed Jesus' family trip to Jerusalem and why Jesus didn't go home with his parents but stayed at the temple for three more days. Inspired students to think about why Jesus said that "the temple is His Father's house" when he was only 12 years old.
